Puahue School Mathematics Target 2018

Annual Aim: To increase the number of student's school wide who are achieving at or above their expected achievement level from 79 to 85%.

Baseline Data: Over the last two years the school has had a focus in lifting achievement in mathematics, this has resulted in an upward shift in results over time. The school has recognised this and provided high quality Mathematics professional development with a consultant, Charlotte Wilkinson, during 2015. Recently completing participation in the ALiM program for 2 years. This has seen a lift in achievement, however there is a need to continue this focus so that we can achieve our Strategic goal of 85% at or above their expected level based on mathematic progressions.

Targets:

- To increase the school wide result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level from 79% to 85% (101/119)
- To increase the Maori student result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level 60% to 83% (10/12)
- To increase the Year 3 student result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level 61% to 81% (18/23)
- To increase the Year 5 female student result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level 50% to 83% (5/6)

Puahue School Writing Target 2018

Annual Aim: To increase the number of student's school wide who are achieving at or above their expected achievement level from 82% (97/119) to 89% (105/119)

Baseline Data: There has been a large focus on learning in mathematics over the past 2 years as part of the ALiM project; we need to continue to focus on Maths in 2018 and also Writing with a goal to support student achievement and sustainability of our programmes.

Targets:

- To increase the school wide result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level from 82% to 89% (105/119)
- To increase the Maori student result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level from 55% to 77% (7/9)
- To increase the Year 2 student result for who are at or above their expected achievement level from 65% to 83% (24/29)
- To increase the Year 4 male student who are at or above their expected achievement level from 71% to 85% (12/14)

Baseline Data: Analysis of school wide writing data in November 2017 identified need to focus on students after three years at school to support enhanced achievement.

- To increase the school wide result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level from to 88% (105/119)
- To increase the Maori student result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level from 77% (7/9) to 88% (8/9)
- To increase the Year 2 student result for students who are at or above their expected achievement level from 62% to 83 % (24/29)
