Cross Country Championship Race - Girls	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child of any age that enters the championship event and finishes the race first
Cross Country Championship Race - Boys	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child of any age that enters the championship event and finishes the race first
Padder Tennis trophy - Girls	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child of any age who wins the padder tennis tournament, through pool play and finals
Padder Tennis trophy - Boys	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child of any age who wins the padder tennis tournament, through pool play and finals
Swimming Championship Race (Boy or Girl, Open age)	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child of any age that enters the championship event and has the fastest recorded time. Times will be recorded to hundredths of a second.
Junior Athletics Champion Boy, Year 1-3	PE Team	Child years 1-3 who has the highest cumulated athletics score based on result for 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> at both school and eastern zone athletics. (If there are children with identical scores from different year levels the cup will be awarded to the child in the highest year level.
Junior Athletic Champion Girl, Year 1-3	PE Team	
Senior Athletic Champion Boy, year 4-6	PE Team	Child years 1-3 who has the highest cumulated athletics score based on result for 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> at both school and eastern zone athletics. (If there are children with identical scores from different year levels the cup will be awarded to the child in the highest year level.

Junior sports person trophy	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Junior student showing the most promise in sport based on their cumulated results in Puahue School and Eastern Zone events and their participation in school team sports.
Senior sportsmanship trophy	PE Team in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	<p><b>This award is weighted</b></p> <p>20% - Contribution and participation in school sports teams and leading sports at Puahue school.</p> <p>60% - Cumulated results in Puahue School and Eastern Zone events</p> <p>20% - Sportsmanship demonstrates the schools virtues consistently in their interactions around sport.</p>

Junior Garden Cup	Garden Judge/s	Child in year 1-3 who, wins the garden competition based on the scoring criteria for both their garden and their garden diary.
Senior Garden Cup	Garden Judge/s	Child in year 4-6 who, wins the garden competition based on the scoring criteria for both their garden and their garden diary.
Enviro Trophy Year 5/6, Boy or Girl	Year 5/6 classroom teacher in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child who consistently demonstrates all the school virtues in relation to leading and participating in environmental activities for the school
House shield	House points highest score	Awarded to the house with the most house points accumulated over a calendar year.

Citizenship Cup Year 5/6, Boy or Girl	Year 5/6 classroom teachers in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child who consistently demonstrates all the school virtues in relation to leading and participating in roles and responsibilities as a senior student at school
Arts Cup Year 5/6, Boy or Girl	Year 5/6 classroom teacher in consultation with Principal and Deputy Principal	Child who demonstrates excellence in all forms of the arts (visual, music, dance, etc) both within the school setting and in the wider community.

Puahue awards are intended to be a celebration of the successes students achieve during their time at Puahue School. They are based on the information collected and collated at the time of consideration for each award.
